- Served 40 years as a Minnesota legislator; was in the House of Representatives (1972-1980), and the Senate (1980-2013).
- Served longer than any other female legislator in Minnesota history.
- Authored hundreds of bills in her legislative career.
- Sponsored the “Minnesota Care” law, which brought affordable health care to hundreds of low-income Minnesotans.
- Chaired Minneapolis Model Cities Board from 1968 to 1972.
- Served on PACER advisory board from 1996 to 2002, an organization focused on information and services for those with special needs.
- Served as member of PORTICO board, which provides outreach to provide health coverage to the uninsured.
- Employed as human services policy reform analyst for Hennepin County.
