- Designed and wrote health care policy and programs which led to better quality and more equitable health care for millions of people across the globe now living free of disease
- Was National College Champion table tennis player -- 1976-1978
- Played on US Table Tennis Team -- 1979-1981, rated #1 on team
- Won Gold Medal (Table Tennis) in 1983 Pan-American Games
- Served on the US Olympic Board of Directors; active in other sports governance bodies
- Worked on several U.S. national healthcare reform measures, including Medicare
- Directed healthcare reform projects, as Chief of Party for 15 years, for four Central Asian Republics after collapse of former Soviet Union
- Served as Vice President of Abt Associates, a global health care consulting firm
- Consulted with multiple countries around the world to develop and improve their health care systems and technologies
