- Skated in the Olympics (1952, 1956, 1960), U.S. National Champion (1958), North American Champion (1959).
- Inducted into U.S. Speed Skating Hall of Fame.
- Appointed to U.S. Olympic Congress (10 years), served as general manager of the 1976 U.S. Olympic team.
- Refereed speed skating in 1980 and 1984 Olympics, 12 world championships and 17 U.S. championships.
- Served on the Technical Committee of the International Skating Union (6 years).
- Played college running back; was all-conference team as fullback (1956).
- Inducted into Gustavus Adolphus College Football Hall of Fame.
- Taught and coached in Minneapolis Public Schools (12 years).
- Worked as National Service Manager at Advance Machine Company, manufacturer of floor-care machines (27 years).
