- Elected to Minneapolis City Council, served 22 years, second longest serving council member in history of Minneapolis.
- Committed major part of his life to volunteer activity, rather than paid employment.
- Served as president of the U of M Alumni Association (2006-07).
- Serves, or has served, on boards of many service and charitable organizations, including Minneapolis Aquatennial.
- Appointed by Secretary of Defense as state chair of the Employer Support of Guard and Reserve.
- Awarded the *Legion of Merit*, *Meritorious Service Medal*, and *Air Force Commendation Medal* (two Oak Leaf Clusters); and *United States Air Force Distinguished Public Service Award*.
- Awarded *President's Gold Medal for Outstanding Public Service*.
